



On the Horizon

Munich-based UTS is known for its dive watches, which are designed to withstand undersea pressures far beyond what most dive watches can endure. Founded in 1999, the company makes the cases itself. Over the years, the watches have proved themselves by diving ever deeper: first to 3,000 meters, then to 4,000. Now UTS is introducing a new limited-edition version of its 4,000-meter dive watch: the UTS 4000M Pacific Blue Horizon.

The 4000M is made from a solid block of German stainless steel. It has a sizable 45-mm diameter and a height of 18 mm. The bidirectional rotating bezel employs a proprietary design, using ceramic ball bearings and a locking crown at 2 o'clock. The watch's sapphire crystal is a hefty 6 mm thick. All the seals on the case are of industrial quality; the caseback is held in place by eight screws.

Inside the case is an ETA 2824-2 "Top" grade movement. The watch hands and indexes have Super-LumiNova coating. The watch weighs 200 grams and comes on a black rubber strap. It is being produced in a limited edition of 200 pieces. Price:
